1. In absence of the President, Shri S K Birla, the meeting was presided over by Shri G K Khaitan, Trustee Member. He welcomed all present.
2. S/Sh. Shri S K Birla, B K Jhavar, Dr. Kusum Khemani, Ms. Sharmila Bose, Mrs. Ruma Mitra, Mr. D J Banerjee & Dr. Krishna Chattopadhyay were granted leave of absence.
3. Minutes of the meeting held on 10.10.2018 were reviewed & noted.
4. The Committee noted and appreciated the performance of the Board Batches of AY 2018-19 of the school mentioning there are further scope of improvement in the future.
5. Some of the Managing Committee members had suggested the following:
 - a) On inspection of the north east side school building which has an emergency iron staircase from the narrow corridor it was observed to be having challenges due to restricted width and steep slope. This staircase would be quite risky for students to use during any emergency. It may not serve the purpose meaningfully.
It was suggested therefore to get a review done by a structural engineer conforming to the norm of fire exit route policy and further redesign the emergency staircase by the architect so that adequate number of students would be able to use the staircase with ease during any emergency.

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The emergency staircase design would be approved by all concerned before fabrication and installation.

- b) To ensure precautionary measures and implementation of all requirements recommended by the Fire Safety Audit team as specified by the Fire Deptt. in totality at the earliest. A time-bound Action Plan would be prepared and circulated shortly.

Audit would be arranged to be done by a second Fire Audit expert to reinforce the earlier Audit recommendations and observation. As per practice fire drills would be regularly done. To ensure that all the fire drill will be jointly done with the college from time to time.

- c) To ensure that PA system is effective to cover the remote corners of the school and college premises. Fortnightly Safety meetings would be held jointly with the college to review all Safety precautions.
- d) To find out any potential threats which may be analysed for further action and implementation.
- e) The MOM would be circulated to all concerned persons for scrutiny and comments.

- 6. There being no other matter, meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
