Academics:

- **Board Examinations (AISSE & AISSCE 2024) -**
 - **AISSE 2024:** Class X examinations were held from 20th February, 2024 to 13th March, 2024. 262 candidates appeared for AISSE 2024. Six candidates are in the CWSN (Children with Special Needs) category
 - **AISSCE 2024:** Class XII examinations were held from 15th February, 2024 to 2nd April, 2024. 246 candidates appeared for AISSCE 2024. Two candidates are in the CWSN (Children with Special Needs) category

- Sanskrit has been introduced as Third Language in Class VI for the session 2024 - 2025
- Value education classes were conducted in collaboration with Ram Krishna Mission in 2023-2024 session and the training of teachers has been carried out for the session 2024-2025
- MOUs have been renewed with Open Doors, Educational Initiatives, NIIT, Gosharp to promote Science, Mathematics and English skills, with Adhayan Digital, Extramarks and Hinnovation to facilitate teaching learning and Accoglobus for sports and games
- NIIT Mathematics modules have been expanded to the Junior section also. Annual Pedagogical Plan outlines focus on Mathematics and mental health

- The school, students, teachers and the Principal won several awards at the local, state and National and International level. - Co-Curricular Activities- School organized Inter house competitions in debate, chess, I-animate, dance, singing, elocution, swimming, Basketball, table tennis, volleyball, English Recitation, science model making, drawing. Regular morning assembly presentations were done by the students. They participated in inter school competitions and won trophies, medals and cash prizes at local, state and National level. - Career Guidance sessions were organized in virtual and physical mode. Need based Social and Emotional counselling was carried out. Anecdotal records were updated for each student from preprimary to class XII twice in a year in the session. CBSE Prashast Form I for all students from KG to class XII and Prashast II for identified students were duly filled (Details in Appendix -B)
- Long Term and Short Term community service projects were carried out by classes I to XII, which included every single student, the most notable being the sale of STEAM exhibition items made by the students with proceeds to be used for social service and the cakes baked by girls' guide to spread smiles in an old age home. The staff members contributed new dresses and funds to help. (Details in Appendix - B)
- Project based online Exchange Programs were carried out at local, National and International level. On 10-4-2024, 5 students, a coordinator and the Principal of Rutland High School, Vermont, USA arrived for a 10-day home stay exchange. Three learning outcomes from Japan visit were implemented in the school by the Principal. Educational Field trips were carried out for all students. (Details in Appendix- B)
