Academics:

- 250 and 231 Students are appearing for **SSE and SSCE 2026** respectively. 5 CWSN students from class X and 5 from class XII are writing their CBSE board papers in 2026
- Regular morning assemblies, Orientations, Parent Counselling, PTMs and Staff meetings were held. **Mentoring Sessions, Remedial classes and extra classes** were conducted as per requirement
- **Online Classes** were conducted for Board Batches X and XII during long vacations
- Students performed well in different **Olympiads, Aryabhata Ganit Challenge by CBSE**
- Students from classes III to VIII appeared for **Open Door and ASSET by EI** to upgrade English, Science and Mathematical skills for the third consecutive year

Special Achievements: (Appendix A)

- **Awards :** The **school** won 13 awards, most notable being (1) 'Environmental Champion School', 'Tech Enabled School of the Year' and 'Secondary School of the Year' at the Global Education Awards 2025 by Scoonews in Jaipur (2) LEGENDS' in the category 'SDG Educator of India' by GSA 2025 at Delhi, (3) The Telegraph School Awards for Excellence 2025 in Academics, Extra Curricular Activities, Maintenance and Eco-Friendly Initiatives and Social Service, (4) 'School with Outstanding Commitment to Inclusivity' and 'Excellence in Faculty Development' by STTAR Excellence Awards 2025 at Delhi.
- The content creation and edition of the TIMES NIE dated 27th November, 2025 was carried out by Shri Shikshayatan School
- The school has developed and launched the '**Shri Shikshayatan Campus**' mobile application. The app is available on Google Play store for parents, teachers and students, facilitating streamlined access to school-related information and communication
- **Co-Curricular Activities-** School organized inter-house competitions in debate, chess, animation, dance, singing, elocution, swimming, Basketball, table tennis, volleyball, science model making others. In inter-school competitions, students won at local, state and National level (**Appendix A1**).
- Long- and Short-Term **community service projects** included every single student, the most notable being the STEAM exhibition cum sale with a collection of Rs. 40,170/- for community service. Relief was provided to flood hit areas of W. Bengal, food sent for NGOs in Sundarbans, Girl guides baked cakes for an old age home. 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grocery to several NGOs. Giving of Mid-day meal ration to four NGOs for children each month continues. The school management donated old furniture and computers to NGOs (**Appendix B**).

Functions and Celebrations: The school celebrated 73rd Foundation Day on 10.01.2026. Several functions were organized and celebrations held in school including Inter school events 'Jubilaré' by the Junior section and 'Words on Wings' a literary fest by the Senior Section (**Appendix B**).

Career Guidance, Internship and Collaboration with Higher Educational Institutes:

- Students attended 15 Career Guidance sessions by Indian and foreign universities. Need based Social and Emotional counselling was carried out. Anecdotal records were updated for each student from preprimary to class XII twice in a year. CBSE Prashast Form I for all students from KG to class XII and Prashast II for identified CWSN students were duly filled.
- Class XI students did **internship** during summer and Puja Break (**Appendix C**).

Exchange Programmes and Field Trips:

Project based online and offline Exchange Programs carried out with schools in Kolkata, Maharashtra, Tamilnadu, Bannockburn High School in Scotland, Whittier Elementary School, Rutland High School in USA. Two teachers and five students from Rutland School, USA visited Shri Shikshayatan School and reciprocal visit by Principal, a teacher and six students took place from 28th May, 2025 to 12th June, 2025. Four students and Outreach Coordinator went to Bangkok for GEIST International Conference and won several awards. (**Appendix C**).

Science and Technology:

Professors from Jadavpur and Amity University conducted experiential learning **science** classes for students. School is collaborating with IIT Madras through the school connect program. Students have won several prestigious science Quizzes. Students participated in a Telescope Making' workshop by Astrophysics Department, Presidency University and received a Telescope. The theme for STEAM exhibition was 'INDIA 2047' with focus on innovation and startups. School team stood first in Future



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Scape: Living with Tomorrow's technology and received a cheque of Rs.25000/- from Chairperson of ISRO and a chance to visit ISRO in 2026.

- **Technology:** IT is taught from class one to class twelve. AI and Web technology are a part of curriculum for classes 6 to 12. Using Bit Coders, students created apps. Students of classes IX and X attended CBSE AI Bootcamp sessions and class X students attended AI summer camp. In AI quiz by The Times of India, school team placed 4th in West Bengal and won RS. 3000; School ranked 2nd at National Level and 1st in W. Bengal and Kolkata as 'AI-INTEGRATED LEARNING CHAMPION' by Education World (**Appendix - D**).

Life Skills, Values and Indian Culture: School has a tie up with Ramakrishna Mission for the last 6 years. Students have won several awards in Sanskrit sloka chanting. Life skill classes are held on a regular basis. Morning Assembly by students is based on Indian culture, life skills and values.

Workshops and Seminars attended by the students and teachers:

- Students attended 34 Interactive Sessions, Motivational Talks, Skill Development and Social and Environmental workshops. The school Alumni organized workshops for students during bag less days.
- Development training sessions were organised for teaching and administrative staff in virtual and physical mode. 190 staff members attended 144 workshops. Teachers completed CBP and Diksha Certification courses. Cyber Security, ChatGPT, financial literacy, workshop on Synergy awareness and a session on POCSO were organized for the entire teaching faculty
- **Workshops attended by the Headmistress** - CBSE Certification - 3, Other Webinars / Workshops - 9
- **Workshops attended by the Principal:** CBSE - 6 Other Webinars / Workshops - 38, CBSE Examination Observer duty - 8, CBSE affiliation Inspection - 3, panelist in 6 seminars, winner of 'Exemplary Principal Award' (Gold) by the Economics times in Delhi at National level and 'International Leadership' award from Geist International Foundation at Bangkok (**Appendix D**).

Infrastructure:

Junior Section has shifted to 8B Lord Sinha Road. Flat interactive panels and ACs have been installed in all classrooms. Fire Safety NOC received for 8 and 11 LSR for three years.

Work in Progress: Structural design for Swimming pool to be converted to labs, classrooms and assembly area done. Block 1 of 11 LSR will be renovated in 2026. Dilapidated building of 8A will be demolished and a new building for the junior school along with a playground constructed. (**Appendix E**).
